



Story Point: Jude said to remember what is true about Jesus.

Big picture question: What will happen for all Christians in the future? One day, all Christians will see Jesus in His glory and live with Him forever.

Circle up!



1. Welcome the kids to church!
2. **GAME:** Run toward truth Write T for truth on a piece of paper and tape it to a wall. Write F for false and tape it to the opposite wall. Explain that you will call out a statement. If the description is true, children will move to the T wall. If the description is not true, they will move to the F wall. Use the statements below or create your own.
 - A dog can bark.
 - Clouds are purple.
 - Ice cream is sweet.
 - A bird meows.
 - A bicycle has wheels.
 - A duck oinks.
 - Jesus is God's Son.
 - **SAY: You know many things that are true. But how can you know what is true about Jesus? By remembering God's Word! Listen to the Bible story today to learn what God's word has to say about the importance of remembering the truth.**

Read the Bible



1. Open your **Bible** to Jude.
 - **SAY: Not everything you read is true, but are all the stories in the Bible true? Yes, because the Bible is God's words! Today's Bible story from the Book of Jude helps us remember God's truth.**
 2. Read the story. (Use the **Bolded** or abbreviated version for younger preschoolers.)
 - **SAY: Mary had other children after Jesus. Her son Jude wrote this letter to encourage other believers. Jude said to remember what is true about Jesus. Jude warned the early Christians to watch out for people who sin and say wrong things about Jesus. Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life—the One who protects His people from sin. Because of Jesus, God will welcome us and give us joy forever.**

Memorize & Pray



1. SAY: **Our key passage is Philippians 1:6.**

- Teacher says verse, then encourage kids to repeat after you. The verse can be broken into parts (see below) for easier memorization!

**“He who began
a good work in you
will bring it to completion
at the day of Jesus Christ.”
Philippians 1:6**

- SAY: **Jude warned believers to watch out for people who sin, but he also reminded them that Jesus is the One who protects His people from sin. Our key passage reminds us that because Jesus already paid the price for sin, we know He will return to bring His people into heaven with Him. God will finish the good work that He began to save us!**

2. Prayer Requests: (Allow children to respond)

3. PRAY for your kids: **God, thank You for the Bible. It is full of true things about You, about Jesus, and about us. Help us trust You and the Bible and remember what is true at all times. Amen.**

Let's practice



1. Give each preschooler an **activity sheet**. Help preschoolers cross out things that can distract us from the truth about Jesus.

- SAY: **There are a lot of things that can distract us from the truth about Jesus! What things are left on your page that help us remember God's truth? Reading the Bible, praying, and gathering with other believers are some important ways to remember what is true about Jesus. Our Bible story today is from a letter written to people who were getting confused about the truth.**

2. While children are coloring, remind them of the gospel gems we learned today:

- **Some people were teaching wrong things about Jesus.**
- **Jude wrote a letter to help people remember the truth.**
- **The Bible helps us know what is true about Jesus.**
