MISSIONS OP



Provo, Utah

College students from our area will go to Provo to do outreach and evangelism with the college students there. They will also work with our church plant partner Mosaic Church which was formed in October of 2020 when a few families and young professionals came together with a desire to see the biblical Jesus shared with the people of Provo. Because less than 0.5% of Provo professes faith in the Biblical Jesus, they intentionally planted Mosaic Church in the heart of its downtown to see the power of the gospel transform the most unchurched city in North America.

East Asia

The team will work with our missionaries doing evangelism and outreach.



Najjanankumbi, Uganda

The purpose of this trip will be to encourage the villagers in Najjanankumbi, evangelize areas outside of the village, and help with a construction project. In addition, we will visit the South Sudanese/Ugandan border and encourage a church pastor there. While at the border, we will reach out to help S. Sudanese refugees currently living in Uganda. They will work with our ministry partner, Africa Renewal Ministries, which works in communities to share the hope of Jesus Christ and provide access to food, healthcare, and education.

Nicaragua/Chosen Children

This team will conduct outreach and evangelism in the Parcels barrio church plant. The team will also hold a Vacation Bible School and possibly a light construction project. They will work with our ministry partner, Chosen Children Ministries. Their ministry is a 24/7 planned with purpose, 365-days-a-year ministry that is laying the building blocks of the Kingdom in Nicaragua heart by heart while sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ.



PORTUNITIES

Port Alsworth, Alaska

Team members will need to be 18 and older. The main activity of the team will be a Junior camp along with some other service and outreach. The team will work alongside Tanalian Bible Camp which works with the Bible-believing churches in rural Alaska. They provide opportunities for evangelism, discipleship, and Christian fellowship through camping, conferences, retreats, and Biblical education.



Nicaragua/Pearl Foundation

The team will work alongside our ministry partner, Nicaragua Pearl Foundation, whose mission is to share the gospel and love of Jesus Christ to the people of Nicaragua through feeding programs, children's backyard Bible clubs, discipleship classes, sports ministries, prison ministries, nourishment at the local dump, and nursing home ministries. The team will help with a children's feeding program, door-to-door evangelism, teaching the Bible and possibly a light construction project.

Spartanburg, SC

This is an exciting new opportunity to serve here at home and all over Spartanburg County. The team will stay together for the week here on campus. Every day will begin and end at the Central campus with projects in different areas of the county each day.



Everett, MA

Join either of our sports trips in Everett, Massachusetts in 2024. The July team will help with a soccer camp and do some community outreach, while the September team will switch it up with a baseball camp. Both teams will work with our church plant partner, Church at The Well, which was planted in 2019 to share the love of Jesus in the town of Everett.

Clarkston, GA

We will have two trips to Clarkston, GA in 2024. Teams will have an opportunity to serve and minister to refugees alongside Send Relief. This area of Atlanta is known as the Ellis Island of the south due to its diverse population, nearly 70% of which is foreign-born, representing more than 50 countries with more than 100 distinct ethnic groups—all living within 1.4 square miles.



Huejutla de Reyes, Mexico

Teams will work with our ministry partner, Esperanza Missions in Mexico doing a construction project and some local outreach.

Charlestown, MA

Teams will work with our church plant partner, Christ Church Charlestown in the Charlestown community right outside of Boston. They will participate in community outreach projects with a focus on the Through Our Eyes Project.

The first team will distribute cameras to the community and the following team will help with setting up the opening night of the show.

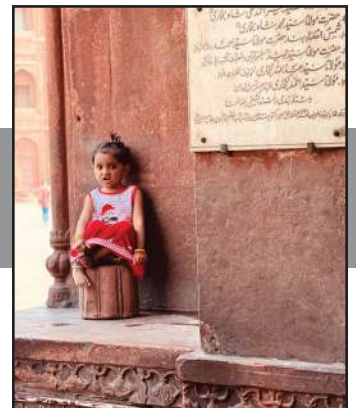


Provo, Utah (Fall Trip)

Teams will work in the Provo area of Utah doing outreach & evangelism with Mosaic church and our other mission partners in the area. This is considered the most religiously hostile city in North America and is the home of the LDS missionary training center for Mormons. There are less than 0.5% evangelical Christians living in Provo.

South Asia

The team will work alongside our missions partners prayer walking and doing outreach with the goal of sharing the Gospel with Hindus and Muslims. The primary focus of this year's trip will be media & medical work.
