Church at The Mill (CATM) highly values investment in developing ministry leaders who demonstrate a passion for Christ, commitment to His Word, and desire to develop world-class ministry skills to most effectively fulfill their ministry calling.

We currently offer the following internship track for those seeking development in Worship Ministry:

Worship Ministry All Campus Intern

The all campus worship internship focuses on the planning, preparation, and execution of weekly programming and special events within the Worship Ministry of CATM. Interns will be exposed to worship ministry across four campuses (Central, Woodruff, Lake Cooley, CATM Español) as well as worship within the Next Gen (Student) Ministry. Interns will participate in weekly worship staff meetings and will have responsibilities related to the effective facilitation of programming and events that include:

- Sunday Morning Worship Services
- Weekly Worship Choir
- Weekly Rehearsals
- Weekly Worship Planning Meetings
- VBS / VBX (children & preteen)
- Creative Arts Camp (children & students)
- Student Camps (middle & high school)
- Worship Leadership at the 2025 Southern Baptist Convention Pastor's Conference in Dallas, Texas.

Summer worship interns will have opportunities to participate in and lead worship across all campuses based on primary skills (vocalist or instrumentalist), have opportunity to lead rehearsal, actively participate in

worship planning, and lead worship with student ministry, including middle and high school camp. In addition, interns will assist with VBS/VBX and Creative Arts Camp. CATM Worship Ministry is responsible for all of the worship at the 2025 SBC Pastor's Conference. Interns will have the opportunity to participate with the 100+ member worship choir and other teams we are taking to Dallas, June 7-10.

HOURS

Intern hours will vary week to week based on the programming calendar.

PAY

Pay for the all campus Worship Ministry internship is \$250/week. Living arrangements are provided. Meals are not provided.

1. Internship application

- Contact and background information
- References
- Video Submission of applicant leading worship or playing their preferred instrument. Footage of the applicant engaged in an actual worship service setting is preferred.
- Permission to conduct criminal background check
- Additional personal & ministry-related questions

2. Interview with CATM Staff

3. Affirmation of core beliefs, expectations, & safety policies
