Each campus is led by a pastor who preaches live and joins a campus staff in shepherding and leading the members and guests of that location. Each Campus Pastor leads under the guidance of our Senior Pastor, who preaches weekly at our Central Campus. We desire to be a deeply-faithful, remarkably-healthy, highly-impactful multi-campus church.

#### CAMPUSES



Our Central Campus is located in Moore, SC near the center of Spartanburg County. This campus is home of the original Church at The Mill location, founded in 1988. Our Church at The Mill administrative offices are located at this campus, including the majority of the church staff and resources.

Central Campus is the largest of the Church at The Mill campuses, which includes NextGen facilities (Kids' Building and Student Center), in addition to a 2,000-seat stateof-the-art worship center. Senior Pastor D.J. Horton preaches live at Central Campus on a weekly basis



The Woodruff Campus, established in 2022, was the first campus birthed out of Central Campus. It is located in the Woodruff community in the southern part of Spartanburg County. The Woodruff Campus worship center seats about 350 people. The campus is currently undergoing construction to renovate the space to better serve the congregation's needs.

Woodruff Campus Pastor Adam Siskey preaches live at this campus location on a weekly basis, coordinating his message with Pastor D.J. and the other congregation pastors. He leads the Woodruff Campus staff to care for their location's members and attenders.



Established in 2023, the Lake Cooley Campus is located in the Northwest portion of Spartanburg County in the Wellford/Inman area. The worship center at Lake Cooley has approximately 250 seats. Between 400-500 people typically attend one of two services each Sunday at this campus.

Lake Cooley Campus Pastor Dylan Baxter preaches live at this campus location on a weekly basis, coordinating his message with Pastor D.J. and the other congregation pastors. He leads the Lake Cooley Campus staff to shepherd the congregation

#### CONGREGATION

#### EAST ASIAN

Our East Asian congregation is an international congregation that meets at the Central Campus. Pastor John Zhang, who is originally from China, leads this congregation in both English and Mandarin languages. The vision of the East Asian Church is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ to all people, especially Chinese and other Asians living in Upstate, SC.

#### ESPAÑOL

We began Church at The Mill Español to reach the large Hispanic population in the Upstate. We desire to make disciples of all nations. We know that the gospel is often best understood in one's heart language, which is why we've begun Church at The Mill Español for our Spanish-speaking neighbors. This congregation launches in Fall 2024

and will meet at Central Campus on Sunday evenings. Our Associate Missions Pastor Andrew Smith currently leads this congregation. With the growth of our church, some of these details continue to change. We are forever grateful for what God is doing across our campuses and congregations!

We have a plan. **Grounded for Life** is Church at The Mill's comprehensive plan for developing graduates who are followers of Christ into college and beyond.

We lay a Foundation in Kids' Ministry by teaching children the overarching story of Scripture, which plants the seed of biblical understanding that will grow and shape the rest of their lives. Then, in Student Ministries, the plan is centered on nine biblical principles that we feel are essential for students to learn and for graduates to have ingrained in their lives. These principles speak truth in three key areas: *Identity, Maturity, and Responsibility*.

Everything we teach kids and students during our programming is centered around instilling these biblical principles in their hearts and minds for life. As graduates step into Young Adult Ministry, these biblical truths are reinforced as we help graduates apply them to their lives as young adults and beyond.

At CATM, we love celebrating milestones with families, from the very moment you know you will be welcoming a child until you launch them into adulthood. As children grow up, we desire to partner with parents to provide "rite of passage" experiences to celebrate the following milestones:

#### BIRTH/ADOPTION —

From the moment you know you will be welcoming a child into your family, Kids at The Mill wants to know! We want to pray for you and offer timely encouragement as you prepare for your child. Please email us at kids@churchatthemill.com to share your joyous news and let us celebrate with you!

## PARENT/CHILD DEDICATION

Twice each year, we host a Parent/Child Dedication service. Dedication services at Church at The Mill are extremely special to our pastors, staff, and families. It is a time for parents to commit their lives to God as the primary influencers in the home and beg His leading and wisdom as they raise their children. We believe children decide to follow Jesus as Savior and Lord when they can truly understand what Christ has done to make a way for their sins to be forgiven. Therefore, we don't believe dedication is infant baptism or a proclamation of your child's salvation.



#### PRETEEN TO MIDDLE SCHOOL

The transition from elementary to middle school is significant, bringing increased expectations and responsibilities. It's a time when a child starts the transition into young adulthood. We offer several events to help make this transition as smooth as possible, including a rising 6th grade orientation.

End-of-Year Celebration, Promotion Sunday, and Middle School Camp. These are all designed to support and guide students and their families during this important time.

#### **BAPTISM**

We pray that we can celebrate this joyous milestone with every family while their kids/students are in NextGen Ministry!

There are many important events in a person's life that are life-defining. None are more significant than the baptism of a follower of Jesus. Baptism is intended to take place after someone gets saved. It is a powerful symbol of life change as one identifies with Jesus in His death, burial, and resurrection. In baptism, a Christian displays obedience to Christ, claims identity with Christ and offers a public testimony about how his/her life has been changed by Christ.

Because baptism is such a special event, we want to do all we can to make it truly meaningful for kids/students and their families. To ensure an understanding of the full significance of baptism, we host several classes throughout the year ("New Believers' Class" in Kids Ministry

and "Baptism 101" in Student Ministry). These classes allow kids and students an opportunity to understand the "why" of baptism and ask any questions they may have. After a class, baptism candidates may schedule a time to meet with one of our pastors to further discuss their spiritual story and the baptism process.

We want to ensure each baptism candidate genuinely understands biblical salvation and their profession of faith in Jesus. While we believe this can happen before eight years of age, we do not baptize any children before they are eight years old.

#### HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

The final milestone celebration a student will experience while in NextGen ministries is high school graduation. This event is so significant that an entire article on the next page describes all we do to launch students into adulthood with the best opportunity to live God's best for their lives.



#### THE SENIOR EXPERIENCE & THE PLAN

The culmination of the Grounded for Life plan for students is the Senior Experience, which serves as a final preparation and launching pad for life beyond high school. The greatest gift Church at The Mill can give graduates is a Senior Experience that grounds them in their faith and produces an individualized plan to help them experience God's best in college and beyond.

At Church at The Mill, the culmination of our comprehensive spiritual growth plan for students (called Grounded for Life) is the Senior Experience. The Senior Experience serves as a final preparation and launching pad for life beyond high school. Through a co-ed Senior Small Group experience, students begin the first semester studying Revelation (its themes and promises are so appropriate for students preparing for an unknown future) and a student version of Financial Peace University (we get the most positive feedback from parents on this).

In their final semester of Small Group, students are led to write a practical and actual plan for how to succeed beyond high school. We've learned that most students don't plan to fail; most just don't plan not to. That is why we lead them in writing a plan that is based on our nine Grounded for Life biblical principles.

#### THE PLAN

We give each student a customized Senior Experience journal where students take notes as we teach each biblical principle and discuss scripture in smaller groups. In addition to the teaching, we invite Young Adults to come share their post-graduation experience and suggest practical and implement beneficial wavs to principles beyond high school. Students develop personal action steps for each biblical principle identified in The Plan, and, together as a group, the students decide on the most practical and helpful action steps for each principle. At the end of the semester, we take their action steps and have them professionally printed into each class's unique version of The Plan as a physical reminder to carry with them into their next stage of life. We encourage students to keep The Plan somewhere they will see it often and review the wisdom and ideas they took time to craft into their plan.

#### THE FIVE

Before students graduate, we also encourage them to identify a circle of five people who can hold them accountable to their plan during their first year of college. A number of studies have shown

that students who have accountable relationships with three to five adults while in college are significantly more successful at thriving spiritually than those who do not. We suggest their "five" include a parent (or two), a senior adult, a past or current mentor (e.g. Small Group leaders), as well as a peer that they admire spiritually. These five have the ability to greatly impact and encourage a student's successful transition to college. We connect these "five" to the student and the plan at a special celebration.

#### THE CELEBRATION

Another way we celebrate this period of transition is by making a big deal of high school graduation. We have a special Graduate Recognition Sunday where our church family celebrates and encourages students. As a part of this special day, graduates invite their families, close friends, and their "five" to a special meal where our whole Student Ministry team further celebrates them. At this meal, graduates share The Plan booklets with their "five" and begin the process of receiving encouragement to thrive as they enter the post-high-school world. This event puts the exclamation point on our preparation of students to be Grounded For Life!





#### THE GIFT

On Graduate Sunday, we present students with special Challenge coins that are custom minted for the Students at The Mill graduating class. Challenge coins are a long-standing tradition in the military that serve as a symbol of identity, a source of pride, and a reminder of the support that a person has behind him/her. We will give these special gifts to our graduating class to serve as a constant reminder of their identity, values, and the army of support they have behind them in their church family. (Some students put these where they can see them daily and some carry them in their pockets when they are having a tough day.)

Through a special Senior Small Group, the writing of The Plan, the formation of accountability circles, the celebration and commissioning service, the banquet, and a special gift, the Senior Experience serves as not only a celebration, but also a launching pad for high school graduates. By making such a big deal of this important milestone, we encourage families, further unite students to the church, and empower students to be Grounded for Life! Our prayer is to give students a purpose, a plan, and the people to help them live God's best for their lives!

We are honored and privileged to be a part of giving them what we believe is a pretty great gift!



#### **Kids Ministry Overview**

Kids at The Mill ministry supports the mission and values of Church at The Mill in leading kids to become grounded for life by discovering and living God's best. We offer opportunities for kids (birth through 5th grade) to experience God's Word.

#### **PRESCHOOL**

(BIRTH-K4)

Our Preschool Ministry is for our children from infants through K4. These are key years for the development and growth of our preschoolers. We are not babysitting, but rather teaching our preschoolers about the love, truth, and the Word of God in fun and creative ways.

#### **ELEMENTARY**

(K5 - 3RD GRADE)

Our Elementary Ministry is for our children who are in kindergarten through 3rd grade. These kids are at an age where many of them are truly able to understand the message of the gospel and their need for a Savior. We not only teach the Bible to elementary kids, but we help them understand why it matters to their lives.

#### **PRETEEN**

 $(4^{TH} - 5^{TH} GRADE)$ 

Our Preteen Ministry is for 4th-5th graders. Our goal is to help preteens know, love and follow Jesus with their whole hearts in a safe, high-energy, enriching environment that bridges the gap between our Kids' and Student Ministries!

(3mo - K5)

At the Early Learning Center, our goal is to nurture your child's mind with age-appropriate instruction and learning experiences by establishing a foundation of God's unconditional love in Jesus Christ. ## SUNDAY MORNING

#### PRESCHOOL (Birth-K4)

Our preschoolers begin each hour in their classrooms where they enjoy teaching, story-telling, play time and snacks. During the hour, our one-year-olds through pre-K kids spend some time in large group with engaging Bible stories and fun worship songs, as well as time on the playground if the weather is nice!

#### **ELEMENTARY** (K5-3<sup>rd</sup> Grade)

Elementary-age kids participate in a combination of Small Groups and large group kids' worship during both hours, with fresh activities and illustrations teaching the same truths each hour. Families have the ability to tailor their service and group attendance and also bring the kids to worship with them as they prefer. Drop off and pick up take place in the kids' classrooms.

#### PRETEEN (4th-5th Grades)

Preteen Small Groups take place during the 9:00 AM hour in the Preteen section of the Kids' Ministry area. We provide a time for age-appropriate Bible study and fellowship as well as the opportunity to join in a specific large group environment for preteens to fellowship together and interact through group learning and games.

Our Preteens have the unique opportunity to participate in Main Worship service with their families during the 11:00 AM service.

#### **KIDS' MIDWEEK**

We offer an unforgettable experience for kids of all ages on Wednesday nights during the Fall and Spring semesters. 

## IS MY CHILD/STUDENT SAFE AT CHURCH?

#### Why safety and security is our highest value for families...

We have the most important message ever to share: God loves us so much that He provided a way through Jesus Christ to receive forgiveness of sin, inherit eternal life, and enjoy a personal relationship with Him that begins on earth and lasts through eternity! We are very intentional about how we share this message and how we combat obstacles that might keep anyone from hearing it loudly and clearly. This is why we place such a high priority on both the PHYSICAL and EMOTIONAL safety of students.

If students don't feel both physically and emotionally safe, it doesn't matter how wonderful the message is or how creatively it's presented; it won't be heard! If parents don't feel like our ministries are safe places, they won't even allow their children to be involved. We work hard to have the reputation that NextGen Ministry provides a safe environment for everyone. From our weekly programs to our in-town or out-of-town trips and camps, we want to be known as a place where kids and students are physically safe and emotionally secure.

To ensure safety and security in our ministries, we follow a security plan with practices that include:

- A team of security professionals, ministry professionals, and reliable adult volunteer leaders
- The use of uniformed and/or plainclothed security personnel
- Secure NextGen facilities during all programming and events
- Regular safety drills to ensure that everyone is prepared in case of emergency
- Policies that serve to protect the physical and emotional well-being of kids, students, and adults
- An electronic check-in process
- An extensive background and screening process for adult volunteer leaders

# PARING Written by Tripp Atkinson, NextGen Pastor

There is a jar that sits in my office that is filled with ping pong balls-168 to be exact. That is the number of hours in a week. 165 of the balls are white and 3 are orange. The white balls represent the average number of hours our kids/students spend away from church. These are the hours spent doing the things kids/students do. The three orange balls represent the average number of hours our kids/students spend each week in our ministry programs. (I realizie that, while we may offer more, most students don't take advantage of everything offered.)

This jar sits in my office to remind me of two important realities. The first reminder is of just how little time we will spend with most kids/students each week. This reminds me that our programming must be excellent. Every minute we have with kids/students must count. We cannot afford to do anything halfway. Every time kids/students are with us, they must be encouraged, loved, and challenged.

This also reminds me of the fact that I am not the primary spiritual influence in a kid's/student's life. That role still belongs to parents. Like it or not, parents have the awesome responsibility of spiritually training and making disciples of their children. My most important role, then, is to partner with parents and support them in this process. I can offer parents relevant biblical teaching for their children each week. I can offer small group settings for their

children to build authentic relationships with their peers under the mentorship of loving adults. I can offer numerous experiences monthly for their children to learn about and engage in worship, serving, and leadership.

Although our staff works tirelessly to ensure these things are offered with excellence, the impact of such opportunities falls short if the experiences and lessons learned are not directly tied back to the home. In order for these lessons to really "take root," they must be reinforced and practiced at home.

For this to happen effectively, we as a Next-Gen Ministry Staff must continue working intentionally to know families and be aware of their needs. Parents must work on continuously being aware of opportunities we offer their family, as well as what happens at our programs and events (what is being taught, how kids/students are being challenged, what commitments their children are making, etc.). As we partner and encourage one another, we can truly be teammates in fulfilling the most important responsibility we will ever have.

Such a partnership between a NextGen Ministry and families can be so effective in offering the best possible opportunities for kids/students to grow in Christ and make a difference for Him. Please know that we are here for you and your family and want to be the best support we can be!
