

Sabbath JULY

Sabbath July is an intentional churchwide effort to build in time for rest. It is a pause on much of our programming for the month of July.

During Sabbath July, all Church at The Mill campuses will continue gathering each Sunday for worship. Our pastors will continue caring for our church family. Our mission teams will continue sharing the gospel in places near and far. Additionally, our administrative offices will remain open during normal business hours as our staff prepares for the upcoming ministry season.

Aside from those ministry functions, much of our regular programming will pause for July. There will be no Adult Small Groups, Equipping Groups, NextGen events, or any activities on our campuses outside of Sunday services. However, there will still be kids' programming available during worship services.

We anxiously await this time of rest and restoration for our church family. We deeply appreciate our lay leaders who devote much time and energy to ensure that our programming runs smoothly and reaches our community for the gospel. Our prayer is that you will not just rest physically, but that you will take this time to rest in the presence of the Lord.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Sabbath July?

Sabbath July is an intentional churchwide effort to build in time for rest. It is a pause on much of our programming for the month of July.

Why are we doing this?

One of the most ignored principles in Scripture is rest—sabbath. Modern culture often focuses on self care, but not true rest. This is our intentional effort to pause for a period of time to reflect on the Lord, His blessings and His presence—without the busyness of regular weekly programming.

Will Sunday worship services still happen?

Absolutely. During Sabbath July, all Church at The Mill campuses will continue gathering at their regular times each Sunday for worship.

Will there still be programming for my kids during worship services?

Yes. There will still be kids' programming available for birth through 3rd grade during worship services. There will be no programming for preteens (completed 4th-5th grades) students (completed 6th-12th grades) during July.

What other programming will happen in July?

Our pastors will continue caring for our church family, including conducting weddings, funerals and other congregational care. Our mission teams will continue sharing the gospel in places near and far. Additionally, our administrative offices will remain open during normal business hours as our staff prepares for the upcoming ministry season.

What programming will not happen in July?

Much of our regular programming will pause for July. There will be no Adult Small Groups, Equipping Groups, NextGen events, or any activities on our campuses outside of Sunday services.

Can my Small Group still meet?

If your Small Group normally meets during this season, use the break to simply enjoy one another. Have a cookout. Gather around a pool. Spend time together outside the structure of normal programming. However, we will pause on-campus Adult Small Group meetings for the month of July.
